Roger Kuhn has worked for the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission for 30 years and is currently the division administrator for the State Parks Division.

Roger received his bachelor of science degree from the University of Nebraska–Omaha. He began his career at the Louisville State Recreation Area in 1981, where he worked as a groundskeeper while attending school. Upon graduation, he began working as the administrative assistant to the former director of the Game and Parks Commission, Eugene T. Mahoney.

When development of Eugene T. Mahoney State Park began in 1987, Roger was appointed the park superintendent. He was responsible for the management of day-to-day operations and the continued development of the largest park operation in the Nebraska park system.

In 1993, Roger became the eastern regional parks manager and was responsible for managing state parks, state recreation areas, and state historical parks in the eastern region of Nebraska. He served in this role until 1994, when he was promoted to the agency's assistant director position and began overseeing the state parks; engineering and operations; and construction, planning, and programming divisions.

Today, Roger is responsible for the administration, operation, maintenance, planning, and development of Nebraska's state park system, which hosts millions of visitors each year and includes 78 parks, two recreational trails, and dozens of programs.
