- Each booth will consist of a 6’ space with draped table and two chairs.
- Set-up can begin at 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 27 at The **Golden Husk, 129 S. 16th St, Ord, NE.** **Your booth must be ready by 5:30 p.m.** Taste & Feel Event will be held from 6:00 – 8:00 p.m.
- Have sufficient samples of your food and beverage products available for tasting. We anticipate approximately 150 people to attend the workshop.
- Furnish supplies necessary for your samplings – ie. plates, spoons, napkins, toothpicks, waste containers, etc.
- Bring your own extension cord if electricity is needed.
- Booth tear down must be done right after the event is over.
- You are welcome to sell your non-alcoholic, packaged products from your booth. Each vendor will do their own selling.
- Proper licensing and certification procedures for sales need to be followed.
- Wi-Fi is available.
